## Satisfy Requirements

This is a three-hour basic introductory food handler training course. Attendees will receive a two-year training certificate that will satisfy the “Designated Alternate” and “on-premises training records” requirements of Section 19-13-B42 of the Public Health Code for Class III and Class IV food establishments. It is also a food sanitation training course for temporary event food booth operators.

This is **not** a ServSafe, Certified Food Manager or Qualified Food Operator (QFO) training.

## Enroll Now!

The cost of the class is \$30. Please call Ledge Light Health District at (860) 448-4882 to enroll. Enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis. To ensure a spot in the class, please enroll early.

All classes are held at the Ledge Light Health District office at 216 Broad Street, New London. **All classes are from 9 am-noon except the March, June and September classes, which will be from 5-8 pm.** The minimum class size is 5 people. Scheduled classes with less than 5 participants may be canceled or re-scheduled.
